CHARTER AMENDMENT

On November 3, 2015 the electors of the City of Farmington passed an amendment, as a result the affected provisions of the City Charter now read as follows:

Section 4.3 - Compensation of Mayor and Councilmembers

Each Councilmember and the Mayor shall receive an annual salary of Three Thousand and 00/100 (\$3,000.00). Such salaries shall be paid monthly and except as otherwise provided in this charter shall constitute the only compensation which may be paid the Mayor or Councilmember for the discharge of any official duty for or on behalf of the city during their term of office. However, the mayor and Councilmember may, upon order of the Council, be paid such necessary bona fide expenses incurred in service on behalf of the city as are authorized and itemized.

Section 5.5. Change in Term of Office or Compensation

Except by procedures provided in this charter, the terms of office of the elective officers and of members of boards and commissions appointed for a definite term shall not be shortened. The terms of elective officers shall not be extended beyond the period for which any such officer was elected except that elective officer shall, after his or her term has expired, continue to hold office until his or her successor is elected and has qualified. The Council shall not grant or authorize extra compensation to any officer or employee after his or her service has been rendered.
