WEEKLY RECAP

August 28, 2017 through September 3, 2017

DWLS and Warrant Arrests

Between August 28 and September 3rd, FDPS personnel made eight driver license related and warrant arrests as a result of conducting proactive traffic enforcement.

Open Door (Vehicle)

On August 28th a Farmington resident made a front desk report stating he heard his car alarm going off at 0445 hours and found his passenger side door open, but did not call the police. It is suspected that the unknown subject that opened the car door was scared off by the alarm.

Possession of Marijuana

On August 29th an Officer stopped a vehicle for speed (85/70) on M5 near Farmington Road. After stopping the vehicle and talking to the occupants, the Officers could smell an odor of marijuana and asked about it. The occupants admitted to smoking earlier and a subsequent search of the vehicle revealed that the driver was still in possession of a small amount of marijuana. The driver was arrested, transported to jail and issued citations for speed and possession of marijuana.

Larceny in a Building

On August 26th a Sergeant took a report of a larceny of a purse that occurred inside a Farmington business. The victim reported that between 1840-2150 hours an unknown subject took her purse from a booth. Business management advised that they were very busy that day and that it would be hard to determine where the purse was when it was taken.

Possession of Marijuana and Narcotic Equipment

On August 29th an Officer stopped a vehicle for speed (90/70) in the area of M5 near Farmington Road. After stopping the vehicle and talking to the driver, the Officers could smell an odor of marijuana and asked about it. The driver advised that there were only "roaches" in the vehicle. A subsequent search of the vehicle revealed that the driver was in possession of a small amount of marijuana and a marijuana pipe/bowl that was located in the center console. The driver was arrested, transported to jail and issued citations for speed, possession of marijuana, and possession of narcotic equipment.

Residential Structure Fire

On August 30th FDPS Personnel responded to residential structure fire on Power Road. Upon entry, there was heavy smoke found throughout the entire first floor and the seat of the fire was located in the basement. Further evaluation and investigation determined that the cause of the fire was an energized coax cable line. The coax line became energized when an electrical service line fell after a tree branch fell on the electrical service line. The fire was determined to be accidental in nature.

Larceny

On August 30th a Farmington resident reported that between 1216 and 1530 hours an unknown subject stole two packages from the front porch of his residence. There are no suspects at this time.

Personal Injury Hit and Run

On September 3rd Officers responded to a report of an injury crash in the area of Grand River Ave and Drake. The driver responsible for the crash fled the area on foot and was suspected to be a drunk driver. Officers quickly learned that the driver responsible for the crash had just fled from a Novi Officer who had attempted to stop the vehicle after almost being hit at an intersection. Officers pursued the suspect with the assistance of a K9, but were unable to locate him. The driver and the passenger of the vehicle that was hit were treated for their injuries. The suspect vehicle was seized and processed for evidence. The case was turned over to a Detective for further follow up.
