WEEKLY RECAP

June 19, 2017 thru June 25, 2017

Intimidation

On June 18th a Sergeant took a front desk complaint from a resident on Power Road regarding an ongoing dispute between neighbors. On this occasion, the reporting party stated that a subject that lives next door stood on the edge of their property line making obscene gestures and statements. The Sergeant contacted the alleged perpetrator, who when questioned about the incident, denied making any gestures or comments. The case was forwarded to the City Prosecutor who reviewed the facts of the case and declined to issue charges in this case.

Possession of Narcotics with the Intent to Deliver

On June 20th Officers observed a moped on Grand River Ave near Lakeway and noted that the passenger was riding in an unsafe manner, facing the rear while using both hand to operate a cell phone. The Officer turned on the moped and noted that it made some overt maneuvers attempting to evade the Officer. The Officer activated the lights and the driver of the moped did stopped after cutting through the parking lot of a credit union. The Officer identified and spoke with the two subjects, and while doing so noticed that the passenger was attempting to conceal a backpack behind them. The Officer however, notice a bottle of liquor in the exterior pocket of the backpack, noting both subjects were under 21. The Officer conducted a subsequent consent search of the backpack and found that the subject was also in possession of marijuana and pills. The driver of the moped was released at the scene and the passenger was arrested and transported to jail. The case was forwarded to a Detective for follow up and is pending lab results and a response from the Oakland County Prosecutors Office.

Minor Possessing Alcohol

On June 22nd a Sergeant stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand River and Halstead after observing the driver fail to use a turn signal and used a lane improperly for turning. While talking to the driver and two additional occupants who were learned to be under 21, the Sergeant noted an odor of alcohol within the vehicle. One of the occupants found to have a BAC of .06(9) and an open arrest warrant for Minor In Possession (MIP) of Alcohol out of another jurisdiction. Another one of the occupants was also found to have an open arrest warrant for MIP alcohol out of another jurisdiction; both were turned over to those other agencies.

Home Invasion

On June 24th Officers responded to a residence on Maple for a report of a possible home invasion. Officers learned that reporting party/victim believes that the father of her child took belongings from her residence without her knowing or permission. The missing items were described to be electronics, clothing, jewelry and two televisions; totaling over \$11,000.00. The residence and area was checked and noted no signs of forcible entry and no witnesses to the theft. The case has been turned over to a Detective for further follow up with the suspect in this matter.

Open Alcohol in a Motor Vehicle

On June 25th an Officer stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand River and Nine Mile for a defective tail light. While talking with the driver, who stated that he had a suspended license, the officer found a can of beer in the center console. The driver was also found to have an open warrant out of another jurisdiction. The driver was arrested, transported to jail and issued citations.
