WEEKLY RECAP

April 18, 2016 – April 24, 2016

ACCIDENTAL PROPERTY DAMAGE

On April 18th at approximately 4:50 PM an officer was dispatched to a residence on the 33700 block of Grand River for a report of damage done to a lawn. Upon arrival the officer learned from the home owner that an unknown person had driven over the lawn and the resident was concerned that they may have damaged his sprinkler service. A report was filed for informational reasons.

JUVENILE MISCHIEF

On April 18th at approximately 7:32 PM officers were dispatched to a fitness facility on the 23000 block of Farmington Rd for a report of juveniles spraying people with water. Upon arrival the officers located the juveniles who advised that they were playing “water wars” which is an annual tradition amongst graduating seniors. The juveniles were advised to leave the business property and were issued no trespass orders should they return by management.

wanted a report filed in case she becomes the victim of further fraud.

On April 19th at approximately 2:27 PM an officer was dispatched to an apartment complex on the 36000 block of Grand River Ave for a report of suspicious damage. Upon arrival the officer learned from management that it appears that one the storage room doors had damage on the door jamb as if someone had attempted to gain entry. It is unknown who caused the damage.

LARCENY IN A BUILDING

Further investigation revealed that the driver had a suspended driver's license. The driver was arrested for driving on the suspended license and an inventory search of his vehicle located a fake shaving cream can with a false bottom that had trace amounts of marijuana in it. The man was housed at the Farmington Jail.

LARCENY OF A SIGN

On April 20th at approximately 12:31 PM a Farmington business owner reported that someone had stolen his temporary parking sign from his business on the 33000 block of Grand River Ave. The business owner does not know who may have stolen his sign.

OPEN INTOXICANTS IN A MOTOR VEHICLE

On April 20th at approximately 6:44 PM a Sergeant on patrol observed a woman passed out in a vehicle with a beer in her hand at Drake Park. The Sergeant woke the woman and she

advised that she was relaxing after a long day at work. The woman was cited for having open intoxicants in a motor vehicle.

In her possession was 2.5 grams of marijuana. The female was arrested for being in possession of marijuana and housed at the Farmington Jail.

On April 20th at approximately 9:13 PM a Commander on patrol stopped a vehicle on the M-5 Expressway for a license plate violation. Further investigation revealed that the driver had a suspended driver's license and warrant for his arrest out of another police agency. The driver was arrested for driving on a suspended license and housed at the Farmington Jail.

POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA

On April 22nd at approximately 4:27 PM an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand River and Tana Ct for speeding. Further investigation revealed that the driver had a suspended driver's license and warrant for his arrest out of a nearby police agency. Upon arresting the driver for driving on the suspended license the officer located 2.1 grams of marijuana in his vehicle. The driver was charged with driving on the suspended license and being in possession of marijuana. The driver was housed at the Farmington Jail.

SMOKE INVESTIGATION

On April 23rd at approximately 1:08 PM officers were dispatched to the Farmington Public Library for a report of an odor of smoke. Upon arrival officers located the smoke coming from the outside cigarette receptacle. The small fire in the receptacle was extinguished.

SUSPICIOUS DAMAGE

On April 23rd a Jamestown Cir resident reported that he had located several dents to his vehicle that he had parked at his apartment complex for the last two years. The owner does not know who caused the damage or when it occurred.

MINOR IN POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL

On April 24th at approximately 3:04 AM a Sergeant on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Shiawassee and Power for speeding. Further investigation revealed that the two underage occupants were in possession of alcohol. The two occupants were written citations for being in possession of alcohol while a minor.

DISORDERLY INTOXICATION

On April 24th at approximately 9:38 PM officers were dispatched to a restaurant on the 35000 block of Grand River for a heavily intoxicated male who has been harassing customers. Upon arrival officers located the man who is well known to the department. The man was heavily intoxicated and had in his possession a half opened bottle of vodka. The man had 6 warrants for his arrest for alcohol related crimes and had a preliminary breath test result of a .28 BAC. The man was arrested for disorderly intoxication and was housed at the Farmington Jail.
