WEEKLY RECAP

October 3, 2016 – October 9, 2016

Felony Arrest

On October 3rd an officer stopped a vehicle in the area of Orchard Lake and Shiawassee for running a red light. While speaking with the driver of the vehicle, the officer determined that the passenger/owner of the vehicle had a warrant for their arrest out of Shelby Township Police Department. The passenger was taken into custody and held in jail until Shelby Twp. Was able to pick them up.

Employee Trouble

On October 3rd a sergeant responded to a Farmington business for a report of a disturbance between two employees. Upon arrival the sergeant learned from management that two of their employees were not getting along, and their verbal argument escalated into a physical fight, at which point, it was alleged that one of the employees threatened the other with a gun. The employee that made the threat was fired on the spot and departed, eventually making their way to the police department to make a report. It was determined that there was, in fact no gun, and that neither of the involved parties wanted to press criminal charges on the other.

Larceny from Automobile

On October 3rd an officer responded to a report stolen property from a commercial service truck. Upon arrival the officer noted broken glass and pry markings on the door of a commercial service (lift) truck which was parked outside of a Farmington business. The officer learned that the crime occurred between 0310-0320 hours, the suspect was captured on surveillance video and the estimated value of the items taken is approximately \$10,000.00. Farmington investigators are currently looking into the matter.

Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia

On October 4th a sergeant stopped a vehicle in the area of M5 and Halsted for not having a visible license plate. After speaking with the driver, the sergeant learned that the driver had a suspended license and warrants for their arrest out of Southfield and Oak Park. The driver was subsequently arrested and during the inventory search of the vehicle a marijuana pipe and grinder were discovered. The driver was transported to the jail and issued a citation.

Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia

On October 4th officers responded to a Farmington business for a report of a male subject using drugs. Upon arrival officers met with and spoke to the reporting party who stated that their spouse had been smoking crack cocaine while caring for their grandchild. Officers discovered evidence of crack cocaine use. The subject was arrested, transported to jail and issued a citation. The child was turned over to a responsible, sober adult.

Aggregated Felonious Assault - Murder Attempt

On October 4th Officers responded to a Farmington Apartment Complex for a reported gun-shot wound victim. Upon arrival the officers located a victim with a gunshot wound to the leg. Officers rendered aid and the victim who was transported to Beaumont Farmington Hills where he was treated and later released. Investigators learned from the victim that two black males, dressed in dark clothing, were seeking assistance and asked to use a phone. When refused, the two forced their way into the apartment and a struggle ensued and resulted in the victim being shot in the leg. The two unknown subjects fled on foot from the area. Investigators continue to pursue leads in this matter.

Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia

On October 6th an officer stopped a vehicle for speed on Drake Road near Drake Heights. While speaking with the driver, who appeared confused and disorganized, the officer reported that they could smell the odor of burnt marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. The driver admitted to smoking marijuana in the vehicle the night before. The officer conducted a search of the vehicle and located marijuana, drug paraphernalia and also found the driver to be in possession of a large sum of cash. The driver was subsequently arrested, was transported to the jail and issued citation(s). The driver was also served with civil forfeiture paperwork.

Open Burning

On October 8th officers responded to a Farmington residence for a report of a homeowner burning in the backyard of their residence. Upon arrival the homeowner was observed stuffing branches into an outdoor stove that was approximately 10' away from the house. The stove was described as over filled, with fire and embers spilling out of it. The homeowner was advised of the open burn ordinance and told to extinguish the fire, which he did. The responsible was issued a citation for open burn.

Operating While Intoxicated

On October 9th a sergeant stopped a vehicle on Farmington near Eight Mile Road for driving without headlights. While talking with the driver the sergeant could smell the odor of an intoxicant and noted that the drivers' eyes were red and glassy. The driver admitted to having four beers in Livonia. The driver completed field sobriety tests, submitted to a PBT and was subsequently arrested for operating while intoxicated. The driver was transported to jail, housed and issued citations.
