### SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

#### Hit and Run Accident

On April 19<sup>th</sup> an officer responded to the Shell Gas Station on Grand River Ave for a report of a U-haul truck striking a gas pump and then fleeing the scene. The officer learned that the U-haul had struck one of the pumps several times before fleeing the parking lot. The U-haul was located at another gas station on Twelve Mile Rd. where the driver admitted to having been at the Shell but claimed that he did not know he had struck the pumps. The man was cited for leaving the scene of an accident.

#### Retail Fraud / Flee and Elude

On April 24<sup>th</sup> an officer was flagged down near the Ollie's Bargain Outlet by an employee and advised that two suspects had just stolen items from the store and were fleeing the scene in a red Pontiac G6. The officer observed the vehicle exit the parking lot and attempted to stop the vehicle using emergency lights and siren. The suspects refused to stop their vehicle and accelerated to over 90 mph on Grand River Ave. The officer terminated the pursuit due to traffic safety concerns. The incident was turned over to the detective bureau for further investigation.
