### SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

#### Harassing Communication

On July 31<sup>st</sup> a Tall Oaks resident reported at the police desk that she is the victim of a harassment. The victim advised the officer that she had hired the suspect to do renovations on a rental property. The victim was not satisfied with the work that the suspect had done, so she withheld final payment. The suspect was upset and sent a text to the victim, mentioning the children's play equipment in her yard. The suspect was contacted and he denied threatening the victim. The suspect was advised to have no further contact with the victim and that any dispute should be pursued in civil court.

#### Mysterious Damage

On July 28<sup>th</sup> an officer responded to a home on Lilac St. for a report of damage done to the victim's vehicle. Upon arrival the officer learned from the victim that her vehicle had been parked inside her garage and when she went out to it on July 28<sup>th</sup>, she discovered that the passenger window was smashed. The victim advised that nothing was missing from the vehicle and she doesn't know how the damage occurred inside her garage.
