### SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

#### Larceny

On July 6<sup>th</sup> an officer responded to Noonan Electric on Nine Mile Rd. for a report of a larceny of a catalytic convertor off of a vehicle. Upon arrival, the officer learned from the manager of the location that the attacked vehicle had been parked in the lot on July 2<sup>nd</sup>. On July 6<sup>th</sup> the manager realized that someone had cut the catalytic convertor off of the vehicle. The case was forwarded to the detective bureau for further investigation.

#### Possession of Cocaine

On July 8<sup>th</sup> officers responded to a report of a woman passed out behind the wheel at a business on Nine Mile Rd. Upon arrival an officer observed the woman reversing her vehicle away from the business and then stop. The officer approached the woman and noted a syringe laying on her lap filled with a dark fluid. The officer asked what was in the syringe and the woman replied that it was apple juice that she has been injecting into her body. A LEIN/SOS check of the woman revealed that her license was suspended. A test of the fluid in the syringe revealed that it was not apple juice, but was actually methamphetamine. The woman was arrested and an inventory search of her vehicle revealed .7 grams of cocaine as well as more methamphetamine. The woman was housed at the Farmington Jail.

#### Larceny

On July 8<sup>th</sup> an officer responded to the Kensington Manor apartment complex for a report of a larceny of a mini motorcycle. Upon arrival the officer learned from the victim that he had parked his minibike on 07/07/2021 and had locked it to a bicycle rack. When he returned on 07/08/2021 he discovered that the lock had been cut and his minibike stolen. The man has no suspects.



### **Flee and Elude**

On July 10<sup>th</sup> officers responded to a report of a road rage in the area of Farmington Rd. and Eight Mile where a heavysset man on a green motorcycle flashed a gun at the opposing driver. Upon arrival, an officer located the suspect driving in the area of Nine Mile and Farmington Rd. The officer attempted to stop the motorcycle, but he immediately fled the scene. ### **Resisting Arrest**

On July 10<sup>th</sup> officers responded to a home on Kirby St. for a report of an ex-boyfriend destroying property and threatening the victim with a golf club. Upon arrival, officers located the man walking on Farmington Rd. from Kirby St. Officers confronted the man and noted that he was intoxicated. Officers attempted to take the man into custody, but same broke away from officers and started fighting. The man was tasered and was quickly subdued. The man was charged with assault and resisting arrest.

### **Trespassing**

On July 11<sup>th</sup> officers responded to the Fresh Thyme Market for a report of a shoplifter. Upon arrival officers learned that employees had witnessed a 50 year old Farmington West Apartment resident stealing items by putting them into her purse. Management advised that the woman admitted to stealing the items, so they allowed her to pay for the items to avoid prosecution. The woman left the scene, but management wants her officially advised that she will be arrested for trespassing should she return. The woman was well known to officers so they located her near her apartment and served her a no trespassing order.
