SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

Larceny

On June 28th an officer responded to a home on Lakeway for a report of a larceny. Upon arrival the officer learned from the victim that the victim’s company is working on a home on Lakeway St. and that on June 25th the victim had hidden a drop hitch around the home. On June 28th the victim returned to the home and noticed several items placed in the dumpster that had been illegally dumped and that his drop hitch was missing. The victim has no suspects.

Gas Leak

On June 29th officers and Engine 1 responded to a home on Power Rd. for a report of an odor of natural gas. Upon arrival the officers noted a strong odor of natural gas coming from the basement. Officers checked the basement with a monitor and noted a level of 13 ppm of hazardous gas. Officers learned that the homeowners had just returned home from vacation to discover that their basement had flooded. Officers determined that the pilot lights for the gas appliances in the basement had been extinguished. Officers turned off gas to the home and turned the scene over to Consumer’s Energy.

Fraud

On July 3rd a Chatham Hills Apartment resident reported that she was the victim of a fraud. The victim advised that she had used Google to locate a phone number for Enterprise Rental Car. Upon locating the phone number, the woman called and spoke with a subject who advised the victim to load \$300 on a gift card. The victim obtained a Go Bank gift card from the Rite-Aid on Grand River Ave and then provided the man with the account number. After waiting several hours for her rental car to pick her up, the victim went to the Enterprise on Drake Rd. to find the business closed. The phone numbers that the victim had called initially are no longer in service. The case has been forwarded to the detective bureau for further investigation.
