### SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

#### Carrying a Concealed Weapon

On November 29<sup>th</sup> an officer was dispatched to the area of Grand River Ave and Drake for a report of a disabled motorist. Upon arrival the officer learned that the driver had ran out of gas. A check of the driver revealed that he had warrants for his arrest out of various jurisdictions and did not have a license to drive a vehicle. A family member arrived to take the vehicle, but a check of her name revealed several warrants for her arrest. While impounding the family member's vehicle, a firearm was discovered in the center console. The firearm was registered to the family member and she was charged with being in possession of a concealed weapon.

#### Defrauding an Innkeeper (Dine and Dash)

On December 4<sup>th</sup> officers responded to the Mi.mosa restaurant on Farmington Rd. for a report of a customer failing to pay. Upon arrival the officer learned that the suspect had ordered \$91 worth of food, ate most of it, and then left without paying. Another officer on patrol located the suspect as she fled the scene. The suspect admitted to not paying her bill and advised that she did not pay because she was not satisfied with one of the meals. The suspect was issued a citation for failing to pay her bill and was released on scene.

#### Accidental Property Damage

On December 3<sup>rd</sup> an officer responded to the Drakeshire Apartment Complex for a report of property damage accident. Upon arrival the officer learned from management that on 11/26/21 she noticed that an unknown vehicle had struck the wall between Drakeshire Apartments and the World Wide Plaza, causing several thousands of dollars of damage. The manager does not know who caused the damage to the complex wall.
