SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

Larceny from Auto

On October 19th an Oxford Twp. Resident reported at the police front desk that a laptop was stolen from his unlocked work vehicle. The victim advises that he had parked his company vehicle at the Great Lakes Ace Hardware in the parking lot while he went inside the store to pick up supplies. The victim returned to his vehicle to discover that his laptop was missing. The victim does not know who stole the computer.

Stolen Auto

On October 22nd an officer responded to the Drakeshire Apartment Complex for a report of a stolen vehicle. Upon arrival the officer spoke with the victim who advised that he had parked his Dodge Charger in the parking lot and when he returned to it an hour later, he noticed it was missing.
