SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

Trespassing

On October 28th officers responded to the Magic Cleaners on Farmington Rd. for a customer trouble. Upon arrival the officer learned from the owner that he has a customer who is refusing to pay and refusing to leave his store. The customer advised that she is upset that the cleaners refuses to stitch a pair of torn pants that she wants repaired so she refuses to pay for the cleaning that she had done. Officers recognized the woman as someone who has been banned from other businesses in the city for causing disturbances in other businesses. The woman was served a no trespass order for the business.

Hit and Run Accident

On October 29th an officer responded to an accident report in the area of Grand River Ave and Drake. Upon arrival the officer learned that the complainant had been driving east on Grand River Ave when a yellow SUV struck him as the yellow SUV was leaving the 7-11. After striking the complainant, the yellow SUV took off and fled the accident scene. A witness to the accident followed the SUV and provided the license plate and driver information to officers. Officers located the at-fault driver who admitted to fleeing the accident scene because he feared getting in trouble. The at-fault driver was arrested for fleeing the scene of an accident and was released with a citation.
