### SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

#### Fraud

On September 13<sup>th</sup> a Valley View St. resident reported at the police front desk that he had been the victim of a fraud. The victim advised that he had hired two men to perform landscaping at his home after one of them had approached him asking for work. The victim paid the suspect \$1,500 to do landscaping but the suspect never performed the work. The incident was turned over to the detective bureau for further investigation.

#### Possession of Taser

On September 16<sup>th</sup> an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand River Ave and Orchard Lake for being an unregistered vehicle. The officer approached the driver and learned that her license was suspended and that she had warrants for her arrest out of a nearby police agency. The officer arrested the woman and when searching her purse, located an illegal taser. The incident was forwarded to the Oakland County Prosecutor’s office for charges.

#### Carrying a Concealed Pistol

On September 18<sup>th</sup> an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand River Ave and Shiawassee for an improper lane use violation. Further investigation revealed that the driver had a suspended driver’s license so his vehicle was impounded by the officer. During the inventory search of the vehicle, the officer located a loaded 9mm handgun in the center console. The driver was arrested for carrying a concealed pistol and charged with the crime.

#### Malicious Destruction of Property

On September 19<sup>th</sup> an officer was flagged down at the Jamestown Apartment Complex by a resident who wanted to report damage done to his car. The officer learned that the victim’s Dodge Charger had been attacked overnight resulting in two slashed tires, a smashed window, and scratches/gouges all

over the vehicle. The victim reports that he believes that a cousin caused the damage because the cousin accuses the victim of having relations with the cousin's girlfriend. The incident was turned over to the detective bureau for further investigation.
