SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

Malicious Destruction of Property

On September 28th an officer responded to the Farmington Crossroads Plaza at Farmington Rd. and Nine Mile for a report of a smashed car window. Upon arrival the officer learned from the victim that she had parked her Chevrolet in the parking lot at approximately noon and returned to her vehicle at approximately 6 PM. Upon returning to her vehicle, she discovered that her rear window had been smashed out. The victim advised that nothing was missing from the vehicle and does not know who may have damaged it. The case was forwarded to the detective bureau to retrieve the parking lot surveillance video and for further investigation.

Flee and Elude

On September 28th the parking enforcement officer noticed a black Camaro parked illegally and without a license plate. The parking enforcement officer attempted to write a parking ticket to the vehicle, but the driver of the vehicle interrupted the parking enforcement officer and fled the scene. An officer on patrol in the area witnessed the Camaro at Farmington Rd. and Freedom and attempted to stop it due to the vehicle not having a license plate. The Camaro pulled over, but as the officer approached the driver the driver put the vehicle into drive and fled the traffic stop. The officer pursued the Camaro, but terminated the chase due to traffic safety concerns. The Camaro was seen again at Grand River and Orchard Lake where officers tried to stop the driver again, but the driver fled the scene. Again the pursuit was terminated due to traffic safety concerns. The driver was identified and the case was forwarded to the detective bureau for further investigation.
