



## WEEKLY REPORT

### **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE (11-4566)**

On August 29<sup>th</sup>, officers investigated a complaint of domestic violence that occurred at Drakehire Apartments. The investigation revealed that an argument over the boyfriend not inviting the girlfriend to Ann Arbor to pick up a friend escalated into the boyfriend knocking the female to the ground and choking her. The boyfriend was arrested and charged with assault and battery.

### **ASSIST OTHER AGENCY (11-4581)**

On August 29<sup>th</sup>, the Michigan Department of Corrections (MDOC) called this department to request that we go to Kensington Manor Apartments and attempt to pick up a parole absconder. Officers responded to the complex and were let into the apartment by the absconder's girlfriend. The absconder was arrested without incident. The absconder was held until the MDOC picked him up.

### **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED/POSSESSION MARIJUANA/OPEN INTOXICANTS IN MOTOR VEHICLE. (11-4592)**

On August 31<sup>st</sup>, at 1:05 a.m., an officer stopped a vehicle for speeding on Grand River near Drake. The officer noted an odor of intoxicants and marijuana inside the vehicle which was occupied by four subjects. An investigation found the front seat passenger had been smoking marijuana and swallowed it when the officer stopped the vehicle. A small amount of marijuana was also found inside the vehicle. The subjects were coming from the Grand Tavern and a half full (beer) pint glass was found on the floor of the back seat. It was learned the back seat passenger brought the pint glass containing beer with him from the Grand Tavern. The driver was found to be intoxicated, failed field sobriety tests and was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (BAC .17). The front seat passenger was arrested for Possession of Marijuana and the back seat passenger was issued a citation for Open Intoxicants in a Motor Vehicle. All four occupants were found to be intoxicated.

**ILLEGAL DISTRIBUTION OF HANDBILLS (11-4605)**

On August 31<sup>st</sup>, a resident of Valley View Circle came into the police department to report that Rite Care Pharmacy on Orchard Lake Road had been placing circulars in the doors of residents along Valley View Circle. A check with city hall revealed that Rite Care Pharmacy does not have a solicitor's permit. Rite Care Pharmacy was contacted and warned about being in violation of city ordinance.

**MALICIOUS DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY (11-4626)**

On September 1<sup>st</sup>, an officer responded to Flanders Elementary School for a report of graffiti on the playground equipment. One piece of equipment was found with sexually suggestive phrases on it written in marker. Photos were taken of the equipment and Farmington Public Schools maintenance was advised so they could remove the marker.

**DUMPSTER FIRE (11-4628)**

On September 1<sup>st</sup>, at 12:30 p.m., officers responded to Farmington Oaks Apartments on a report of a dumpster fire. Upon arrival, the dumpster was fully involved. Officers quickly extinguished the fire with a handline. The cause of the fire is unknown.

**MENTAL (11-4634)**

On September 1<sup>st</sup>, officers were dispatched to a report of man walking in front of Farmington High School threatening to kill someone on a cell phone. Officers located the man walking south on Power Road near Valley View. The man was highly agitated and was yelling at an unknown person on the phone. Officers learned that the man is Manic Depressive, Schizophrenic and upset with his mother who is his guardian. The man's aunt showed up on the scene and advised that her nephew is either not taking his medication, or needs his medication adjusted. Officers talked with the man's mother, who is his guardian, who advised that she will have her son evaluated by his doctor in the morning. The man was turned over to his aunt.

**MENTAL (11-4636)**

On September 1<sup>st</sup>, officers were dispatched to the Orchard Liquor and Fine Wine Party Store on a report of customer trouble. Upon arrival the store employees advised that a white male entered the business screaming and yelling about various government conspiracies and then left when ordered to by the staff. Officers located the subject who was on Grand River Avenue. The subject was highly agitated complaining about President Obama and the numerous conspiracies associated with him. The man admits that he is Schizophrenic and agreed to go home and stop being disorderly.

**INDECENT EXPOSURE/DISORDERLY INTOXICATION (11-4677)**

On September 3<sup>rd</sup>, at approximately 9:00 p.m., officers responded to the parking lot of Luigi's Italian Dining on Farmington Road for a report of two subjects in a

black Oldsmobile engaging in sexual intercourse. Upon arrival officers located the naked male and female parked near the entrance to Luigi's. Both subjects were arrested for indecent exposure and disorderly intoxication. The subjects were held until sober and released with a citation.

**DRIVING WHILE LICENSE REVOKED/POSSESSION of MARIJUANA/  
WARRANTS OTHER DEPARTMENT (11-4683)**

On September 4<sup>th</sup>, at 2:30 a.m., an officer stopped a vehicle for an improper turn violation on Eight Mile and Farmington Road. The driver of the vehicle was found to have a revoked driver's license and was arrested for this. Upon arrest the driver was found to be in possession of Marijuana and also charged with the possession. The driver had a prior conviction for driving on a suspended license. The passenger was found to have a warrant out of the Livonia Police Department. The passenger posted \$850 bond for the Retail Fraud warrant.
