POSSESSION OF ILLEGAL FIREWORKS (11-4962)

On September 19th, an officer observed a vehicle make a prohibited right turn on red at Halsted and Grand River. The vehicle was stopped on the westbound M-5 entrance ramp near Halsted. A consent search of the vehicle yielded illegal fireworks in the trunk. The officer confiscated the Thunder Bomb firecrackers and Moon Rocket bottle rockets. A citation for possession of illegal fireworks was issued to the driver/owner.

OPERATE WHILE INTOXICATED/POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA (11-4971)

On September 19th, at approximately 7:18 p.m., a resident of Maple Street called this department to report a man who apparently fell asleep in a Jeep Grand Cherokee in front of the complainant's home. In addition, the complainant suspected that the man was intoxicated because he has an open can of beer in his center console. While officers were enroute to the scene, the man woke up and started driving north on Maple towards Grand River Avenue. Officers located the man in the parking lot of Anchor Chiropractic attempting to back out of a parking space. Officers discovered that the man was highly intoxicated and he was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI). A subsequent search of the man's Jeep revealed approximately ten ounces of marijuana plus approximately twelve empty cans of beer and one opened beer that the man had been drinking. The man is being charged with possession of marijuana and OWI.

SUSPICIOUS PERSON (11-4974)

On September 19th, at approximately 9:12 p.m., officers were dispatched to a report of a suspicious male in the backyard of a home on Vicary Street. Upon arrival officers learned from the complainant that she had been talking on her phone on her backyard deck when she observed an unknown male hiding near a pine tree. The complainant called out to the man who walked away from the complainant towards Saxony Road. Officers checked the area and were unable to locate the subject.

LARCENY IN A BUILDING (11-4992)

On September 20th, at approximately 10:29 p.m., an officer was dispatched to a report of an attempted larceny in a building at the Kensington Manor Apartments. Upon arrival the officer learned that a resident of the apartment complex went to the basement of the building and discovered two males attempting to steal items from the storage units inside. The complainant grabbed onto one of the men, an unknown black male, and was able to take a green army style bag that the male had been holding onto. The bag contained a set of bolt cutters in it and appears to have belonged to the suspects. The suspects had left the scene prior to the officer's arrival.

WARRANT OTHER POLICE DEPARTMENT (11-4996)

On September 21st, an officer observed a subject walking on the sidewalk eastbound Grand River near Whittaker. The subject appeared to be drinking from a can wrapped in a bag. The officer made contact with the subject at Grand River/Whittaker. The subject was consuming an energy drink. The subject requested a ride and the officer received identification. The subject had an outstanding bench warrant out of Madison Heights for Driving While License Suspended. The warrant was confirmed with Madison Heights Police Department and they wished to pick up the subject. The subject was arrested on the warrant and subsequently turned over to the Madison Heights Police Department.

SOLICITOR COMPLAINT (11-5013)

On September 21st, at approximately 7:20 p.m., officers were dispatched to the Warner Farm's subdivision for a report of a solicitor in the area. The complainant advised that the solicitor had asked to come inside her home in order to have a drink of water. Officers located the subject who was selling coupon books for an advertising company. The man did not have a permit to solicit in the city of Farmington and was cited.

LARCENY FROM VEHICLE (11-5014)

On September 21st, at approximately 7:15 p.m., a worker for Rainbow Rehab went out to the company van and found the passenger side window smashed out and a GPS unit missing. The worker advised that he had parked the vehicle in the parking lot behind Rainbow Rehab on Grand River Ave at approximately 6:30 p.m. There is no suspect information.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED (11-5018)

On September 22nd, an officer observed a vehicle make wide right turns at the intersections of Orchard Lake/Eight Mile and Eight Mile/Farmington Roads. The vehicle had to enter the lane of opposing traffic in order to complete the turn. The officer stopped the vehicle at Farmington Road and Cadillac. The officer detected an odor of intoxicants in the vehicle. The driver admitted to having a

few beers at the Thunder Bird bowling alley in Troy. The driver failed field sobriety tests and submitted to a PBT with a result of .10(2). The driver was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI). A breath test at the station yielded a BAC of .10 and .09. The officer issued a citation for OWI and the twenty-seven year old driver was held until sober.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED (11-5020)

On September 22nd, an officer observed a vehicle travelling eastbound on Grand River near Halsted at 03:30 a.m. with no headlights activated. A traffic stop was conducted on Grand River near Blanchard. The officer detected an odor of intoxicants coming from the interior of the vehicle. The driver admitted to having one beer at the Post Bar in Novi. The driver failed field sobriety tests and submitted to a PBT with a result of .10(3). The driver was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI). The vehicle was turned over to a passenger. A breath test at the station yielded a BAC of .11 and .11. The officer issued a citation for OWI and the twenty-one year old driver was held until sober.

IDENTITY THEFT (11-5028)

On September 22nd, a resident of Brookdale Condominiums reported that his identity had been stolen. The resident stated that in 2010 he did not file any tax returns because he did not earn any income; however, the IRS was reporting that he had. The resident looked into it further and discovered that someone had used his name and social security number to file a tax return. The case was forwarded to the detective bureau for further follow-up.

FRIEND OF THE COURT WARRANT ARREST (11-5058)

On September 24th, an officer stopped a vehicle on Grand River and Sherwood for a defective tail light. The officer obtained identification from the driver and ran the driver through LEIN/SOS. The driver's information returned with several outstanding Friend of the Court warrants out of Wayne County Sheriff's Department totaling over \$37,000. The warrant was confirmed by Wayne County as valid and they wished to pick up the driver. The driver was arrested on the warrants and lodged by this department.

MARIJUANA POSSESSION (11-5060)

On September 24th, an officer observed a vehicle northbound Halsted at Grand River with a defective tail light and bright lights activated. A traffic stop was conducted on Halsted north of Grand River. The officer detected the odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. The driver acknowledged smoking a joint earlier in the day but denied possessing it. The officer conducted a search of the vehicle and located a 3.8 gram baggie of suspected marijuana in the interior pouch of the driver's side door. The marijuana was confiscated and the driver arrested for marijuana possession. The vehicle was impounded. The driver was issued a citation for marijuana possession and was subsequently released after posting bond.

**OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED/DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED
(11-5073)**

On September 25th, an officer observed a vehicle travelling westbound on Grand River near Orchard Lake at over 60 mph. A traffic stop was conducted at Grand River/Power for speed and improper lane use. The officer detected an odor of intoxicants coming from the interior of the vehicle. The driver failed field sobriety tests with a PBT of .15. The driver was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI). The driver also had twenty-five outstanding suspensions on his driving record. A passenger took custody of the vehicle. The driver refused a breath test at the station and a search warrant for blood was obtained. Blood was drawn by CEMS and shipped to the Michigan State Police crime lab for analysis. The driver received a citation for OWI/DWLS and was housed until sober.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED (11-5074)

On September 25th, an officer observed a vehicle disregard the red traffic signal at Grand River and Orchard Lake. The officer also observed the vehicle to be straddling the lane markers of westbound Grand River from Orchard Lake to Grove Street. A traffic stop was conducted at Grand River and Grove. The officer detected an odor of intoxicants coming from the interior of the vehicle. The driver admitted to having a few beers at a friend's residence. The driver failed field sobriety tests with a PBT of .09(1) and .10(2). The driver was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) and his vehicle impounded. The driver took a breath test at the station with a BAC of .11/.11. The driver was housed until sober and received a citation for OWI.
