



WEEKLY REPORT

December 26, 2011 – January 1, 2012

SUSPICIOUS CIRCUMSTANCE

On December 27th, a resident on Manor Court at Kensington Manor Apartments came into the front desk of the station to report that someone damaged his mailbox over the holiday weekend.

SUSPICIOUS PERSON

On December 27th, at approximately 9:20 p.m., an employee of O'Reilly Auto reported seeing a male wearing a blue jacket looking into windows in the plaza. Officers checked the area, but were unable to find the subject.

FRIEND OF THE COURT WARRANTS

On December 29th, at 2:30 a.m., an officer observed an occupied parked vehicle in the lot of the Shell gas station. The business was closed and the parking lot dark. The officer made contact with the individuals who were waiting for a friend who had run out of gas on M-5. The driver was identified and run via LEIN/SOS. The driver had two outstanding Friend of the Court warrants out of the Wayne County Sheriff's Office (WCSO) with a bond over \$52,000. The warrants were confirmed and the driver arrested. The driver was held by this department pending pick up by the WCSO. The vehicle was impounded.

LARCENY FROM AUTO

On December 20th, an employee of Farmington Health Care reported that sometime between 6:50 a.m. – 10:00 a.m., somebody had broken out the driver side window of her vehicle and stole her purse. There are no suspects at this time.

SUSPICIOUS CIRCUMSTANCE

On December 20th, a patron of Chase Bank came into this police department reporting that he thought that two individuals were watching him and acting strange. The patron did not obtain a license plate number, there are no suspects.

SOLICITOR COMPLAINT

On December 30th, at 10:50 a.m., officers responded to the area of Vicary and Tree Hill for a report of a solicitor in the area. The solicitor for Green Construction was located and it was determined that he did not have a permit to solicit business in this city. The man was issued a citation and advised to obtain a permit before soliciting any further.

LARCENY IN A BUILDING

On December 30th, a former resident of Drakeshire Apartments who was in the process of moving out between the dates of December 19 – 29, reported that two rings were stolen from her apartment. The rings were last known to be in a jewelry box in the bathroom. The Detective Bureau is following up with individuals who had access to the apartment during those times.

JUVENILE MALICIOUS MISCHIEF

On December 30th, at approximately 11:30 p.m., an officer observed a juvenile changing the sign in front of Burger King to read "Try our Nude Ass". Burger King management did not wish to pursue any charges against the juvenile. Juvenile was turned over to his mother.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED IV

On December 31st, at 3:30 a.m., an officer observed a vehicle eastbound on Eight Mile Road near Farmington Road with a broken tail light emitting white light to rear. A traffic stop was conducted on Eight Mile Road near Mayfield. The officer observed the driver to have glassy eyes and slurred speech. The officer detected an odor of intoxicants coming from the interior of the vehicle. The driver failed field sobriety tests and submitted to a PBT with a result of .18(6). The driver was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI). The driver had three prior OWI convictions out of Novi, Bloomfield Hills and Livonia. The vehicle belonged to the passenger who was cited for allowing an intoxicated/revoked driver to drive. The vehicle was turned over to the passenger. The driver submitted to a breath test with a BAC of .15/.13. The report will be forwarded to the Oakland County Prosecutor's Office for OWI IV and Driving While License Revoked.

SMOKE INVESTIGATION

On December 31st, officers were dispatched to Farmington Place regarding smoke coming from an apartment on the third floor. Upon arrival, officers determined the smoke originated from a careless cook in the unit. Maintenance assisted the officers with ventilation.

DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED

On December 31st, at approximately 6:40 p.m., an officer on patrol observed a vehicle with an expired license plate tab of July of 2011. Subsequent to a traffic stop on the vehicle, it was found that the driver had numerous suspensions on her driving record along with an outstanding warrant out of Detroit for "Failing to Display a Valid License." The subject was arrested for Driving While License Suspended and the outstanding warrant.

NEVER ACQUIRED LICENSE ARREST

On December 31st, an officer on patrol observed a vehicle traveling without it's headlights on after dusk. Subsequent to a traffic stop on the vehicle, it was found that the driver did not have a driver's license and only had a Nevada personal identification card. The driver was arrested for Never Acquired Driver's License.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED 2nd OFFENSE

On December 31st, at approximately 11:50 p.m., an officer on patrol observed a vehicle fail to stop for the red traffic signal at westbound Eight Mile Road and Farmington Road.

Subsequent to a traffic stop on the vehicle it was found that the driver was Operating While Intoxicated (OWI). The driver had a prior conviction for OWI on his driving record and was subsequently arrested for OWI 2nd.

OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED/CONCEALED PISTOL LICENSE VIOLATION

On January 1st, an officer observed a vehicle travelling at a high rate of speed on westbound Grand River near Gill. The officer paced the vehicle at 58 mph and observed it change lanes without utilizing a turn signal. The vehicle was also weaving within its lane. A traffic stop was conducted. The officer detected an odor of intoxicants coming from the vehicle. The driver admitted to consuming alcohol at a friend's residence. The driver also had a valid Concealed Pistol License (CPL) and was carrying a handgun. The officer confiscated the weapon and had the driver perform field sobriety tests. The driver failed the tests and submitted to a PBT with a result of .12. The driver was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) and a CPL violation. The driver submitted to breath test at the station with a BAC of .12/.12. The driver was issued a citation for OWI/CPL violation and housed pending bond. The handgun will be forfeited for being carried in violation of the CPL laws.

BREAKING AND ENTERING COMMERCIAL BUILDING

On January 1st, officers were dispatched to an alarm showing front door entry and glass breakage at Radio Shack. Upon arrival, officers found the front door had been smashed with a concrete block and it appeared that the register had been stolen from the sales counter. Further investigation revealed that the electrical meter box had been tampered with and the electrical meter was removed and missing. The area was checked, but no suspect(s) were found in the area.
