



## WEEKLY REPORT February 20 - 26, 2012

### **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED**

On February 20<sup>th</sup>, a sergeant stopped a vehicle on Farmington Road near Alta Loma for an equipment violation. The driver of the vehicle had a strong odor of intoxicants on her breath and admitted to drinking at her home in Clinton Township. The sergeant conducted field sobriety tests and arrested the driver for Operating While Intoxicated. A subsequent Datamaster breath test at the station revealed that driver to have a blood alcohol level of .22.

### **LARCENY OF COPPER**

On February 21<sup>st</sup>, a report was made that a home was broken into in the 36000 block of Mission Court. Sometime in the past week, an unknown suspect(s) gained entry to the home and took between \$2,500 and \$5,000 worth of copper pipe.

### **DRUG PARAPHERNALIA**

On February 22<sup>nd</sup>, an officer observed a vehicle westbound on Grand River and Drake travelling with bright lights activated. The vehicle also had a dangling driver side external mirror. A traffic stop was conducted at Grand River and Blanchard. The officer detected an odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. A search of the vehicle was conducted. The officer located two glass marijuana pipes in a book bag belonging to the driver. The driver was cited for possession of drug paraphernalia, driving with bright lights activated and an equipment violation and given a court date. The driver was then released with the citation. The marijuana pipes were discarded in compliance with departmental policy.

### **POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA**

On February 22<sup>nd</sup>, at 12:30 p.m., an officer stopped a vehicle on Farmington Road near Eight Mile for a traffic violation. An odor of marijuana was noted inside the vehicle. A search of the vehicle found marijuana and the driver admitted he smokes it and does not have a medical card. Driver was arrested and charged with possession of marijuana.

### **DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED/WARRANTS OTHER POLICE DEPARTMENT**

On February 22<sup>nd</sup>, an officer stopped a vehicle in the area of Grand River and Mooney for having illegally tinted windows. Through the officer's investigation he learned that the driver has nine suspensions on her driving record and five warrants for her arrest. The woman was arrested for Driving While License Suspended and was turned over to the Detroit Police Department for the outstanding warrants.

### **LARCENY IN A BUILDING**

On February 23<sup>rd</sup>, at 2:00 p.m., the management of Farmington Health Care reported the

theft of a patient's personal property. An officer responded for the report as this is the third such report in the past three months. The case(s) are currently under investigation by detectives.

#### **DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED/WARRANT OTHER POLICE DEPARTMENT**

On February 23<sup>rd</sup>, an officer stopped a vehicle for speeding at Grand River and Farmington Road. A subsequent investigation by the officer revealed that the driver had a suspended license and a warrant for his arrest. The driver was arrested for Driving While License Suspended and was turned over to Southfield Police Department for the warrant.

#### **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED**

On February 24<sup>th</sup>, an officer observed a vehicle changing lanes multiple times and driving erratically on Grand River near Smithfield. A traffic stop was conducted. The officer detected an odor of intoxicants coming from the interior of the vehicle. The driver had attended a Korn concert and after hours party and admitted to consuming four to five drinks. The driver failed field sobriety tests with a PBT of .13(2). The driver was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated. The driver submitted to a breath test at the station with a result of .15 and .14. The driver received a citation for Operating While Intoxicated and was held pending sobriety.

#### **DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED/WARRANTS OTHER POLICE DEPARTMENT**

On February 24<sup>th</sup>, an officer stopped a vehicle for speeding in front of Farmington High School. A subsequent investigation by the officer revealed that the driver had four suspensions on her driving record and three warrants for her arrest. The woman was arrested for Driving While License Suspended and held until she posted bond on all the warrants.

#### **DUMPSTER FIRE**

On February 25<sup>th</sup>, officers were dispatched to a report of a dumpster on fire in the back lot of the Crossroads Plaza. Upon arrival officers noted that the dumpster was fully engulfed in flames. Officers extinguished the dumpster using foam and very little water from Engine 3. Officers were unable to determine the cause of the fire.

#### **OPEN INTOXICANTS IN A MOTOR VEHICLE/WARRANT OTHER POLICE DEPARTMENT**

On February 26<sup>th</sup>, an officer conducting an "Apartment Watch" at Kensington Manor Apartments at 3:00 a.m. and observed an occupied vehicle running in the parking lot near the closed rental office. The officer observed a female sleeping in the passenger seat. The driver's seat was unoccupied. The officer identified the female and learned she was awaiting the return of her boyfriend who was assisting a resident of the complex. The officer ran the female via LEIN and learned she had several warrants out of Detroit Police Department including a "no bond" warrant for assault. The warrants were confirmed with the Detroit Police Department who advised they would pick up the female. A search of the female upon arrest yielded a silver flask containing tequila in her jacket. The contents of the flask were poured out and a citation for Open Intoxicants in a Motor Vehicle was issued to the female. The female was then housed for the Detroit Police Department.

#### **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE**

The department responded to two domestic violence cases during the week.
