



## WEEKLY REPORT May 7 – 13, 2012

### **MALICIOUS DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY**

On May 7<sup>th</sup>, at 8:05 a.m., employee of Farmington Health Care reported that someone had thrown four small rocks through a window at the business causing damage. A similar report was made at a different business recently.

### **SUSPICIOUS CIRCUMSTANCE**

On May 7<sup>th</sup>, an officer was dispatched to a resident on Frederick Street at approximately 4:25 p.m. for a report of possible larceny of mail. Upon arrival the complainant advised that on May 5<sup>th</sup> she noted two brown packages on her front porch that the mail person had placed. The complainant went outside and retrieved her packages. When she went back inside she looked out her window and observed a white male placing a similar package into a white vehicle and she doesn't know if the man had stolen one of her packages. The complainant advised that she wanted to talk with her mail person prior to making a police report, but that her mail person advised her to contact the post office because he had not been working on the 5<sup>th</sup>. The complainant is to call the department back should she discover that something was missing from a mail order.

### **DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED/FELONY WARRANT OTHER AGENCY**

On May 8<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 11:22 p.m., an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle in the area of Nine Mile Road and Farmington Road for an illegal lane use. A subsequent investigation revealed that the driver has seven suspensions on her record and a felony probation warrant out of the 6<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court for Forgery. The driver was arrested and lodged at the Farmington jail.

### **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED**

On May 9<sup>th</sup>, an officer observed a vehicle travelling at approximately 55 mph in a 35 mph zone near Grand River and Gill. The officer also noted the vehicle to cross the double yellow line near Grand River and Cass. A traffic stop was conducted on Grand River near Warner. The officer detected an odor of intoxicants coming from the vehicle. The driver admitted to having two glasses of wine at a bar in Southfield. The driver failed field sobriety tests with a PBT of .14(6). The driver was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) and the vehicle was impounded. The driver submitted to a breath test at the station with a result of .17 and .16. The officer issued the driver an OWI citation. The driver was held until sober.

### **PRIVATE PROPERTY ACCIDENT**

On May 9<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 7:06 p.m., officers were dispatched to a report of a single car accident at Farmington First Baptist Church. Upon arrival officers learned that the driver had

been driving through the church parking lot when she struck a Detroit Edison light pole and knocked it down, causing a minor power outage in the local area. No one was injured due to the accident and DTE was contacted reference the power line.

### **SOLICITORS**

On May 10<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 6:50 p.m., an officer was dispatched to a report of door to door solicitors in the area of Larkspur and Flanders. Upon arrival the officer located the juvenile solicitors who had a Farmington Hills solicitor's permit but not a Farmington permit. The juveniles were advised on city borders and sent on their way.

### **MALICIOUS DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY**

On May 11<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 4:27 p.m., an officer was dispatched to Kensington Manor Apartments for a report of damage done to a mailbox. Upon arrival the officer learned that the damage was done sometime between May 7 – 11, 2012 by an unknown suspect. The damage was discovered by the postal carrier and it is unknown if any mail was stolen. The occupant who owns the mailbox and the complex management were advised.

### **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED**

On May 12<sup>th</sup>, an officer observed a vehicle make a prohibited right turn on red from Grand River to Halsted. A traffic stop was conducted on Halsted near Grand River. The officer detected an odor of intoxicants coming from the vehicle. The driver admitted to consuming some beers at a bar in Farmington Hills. The driver failed field sobriety tests with a PBT of .23(6). The driver was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI). The driver submitted to a breath test at the station with a result of .21 and .21. The driver received a citation for OWI and was held until sober.

### **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED**

On May 12<sup>th</sup>, an officer on a traffic stop performing field sobriety tests became concerned when a vehicle drove past his location on several occasions and parked nearby. The officer recognized the vehicle as the one seen following the vehicle involved in the traffic stop. The officer made contact with the driver who appeared intoxicated. The officer detected an odor of intoxicants coming from the vehicle. The driver admitted to consuming beers at a bar in Farmington Hills. The driver failed field sobriety tests with a PBT of .09(6). The driver was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI). The driver submitted to a breath test at the station with a result of .11 and .10. The driver was issued a citation for OWI and held until sober.

### **OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED**

On May 12<sup>th</sup>, an officer paced a vehicle at 85 mph in a 70 mph zone on westbound M-5 from Farmington Road to Halsted. A traffic stop was conducted. The officer detected an odor of intoxicants coming from the vehicle. The driver admitted to consuming alcohol at a friend's residence in Ferndale. The driver failed field sobriety tests with a PBT of .14. The driver was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) and the vehicle impounded. The driver submitted to a breath test at the station with a result of .14 and .15. The driver was issued a citation for OWI and held until sober.

**CIVIL MATTER**

On May 12<sup>th</sup>, at 3:00 p.m., officers responded to a child custody issue. Investigation found any type of complaint or allegations would fall under Florida jurisdiction. Officers took a report and made contact with Florida authorities.

**JUVENILE MISCHIEF**

On May 12<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 6:54 p.m., officers were dispatched to a report of several juveniles climbing on the roof of the Farmington Water Treatment Plant. Officers arrived on scene and noted that the outside perimeter fence was still secure. Officers checked the building and the roof but did not locate any juveniles.

**MALICIOUS DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY**

On May 13<sup>th</sup>, at 2:30 a.m., an officer conducting an Apartment Watch at the Kensington Manor Apartments observed nine vehicles which had been spray painted and tampered with. The damage was documented and photographed. No suspect information was available.

**POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA**

On May 13<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 11:00 p.m., an officer stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation in the area of Nine Mile Road and Farmington Road. While interviewing the driver the investigating officer noted marijuana remnants on the floor of the vehicle as well as paraphernalia. A subsequent search of the vehicle revealed one marijuana cigarette. The driver was arrested and cited for Possession of Marijuana/Paraphernalia.
