## WEEKLY REPORT

### January 7 - 13, 2013

#### **UPDATE - FELONIOUS ASSAULT**

On December 26<sup>th</sup>, at 12:34 p.m., officers responded to Grand River and Grove on a possible felonious assault. A subject was waving a gun from a SUV. The area was checked and the vehicle had left the area.

Upon investigation of details, the incident could not be verified based on the interview of witnesses and surveillance video of the area.

#### **THREATENING COMPLAINT**

On January 7<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 4:39 p.m., a resident on Lilac Street came into this police department to report that her cousin's boyfriend threatened to harm the resident because the resident call the Livingston County Sheriff's Office and requested that they check on her cousin's welfare since she had not heard from them for several days. The resident advised that her cousin and her cousin's boyfriend are both drug addicts and they were both upset that deputies were at their home. The two were contacted and advised to have no contact with the resident.

#### **UNLAWFUL DRIVING AWAY OF AUTOMOBILE**

On January 10<sup>th</sup> a homeowner on Floral Street reported his 2002 black Dodge Ram stolen from the front of his residence between 8:00 p.m. on January 9<sup>th</sup> and 7:00 a.m. on January 10<sup>th</sup>. The homeowner claimed he locked the vehicle and had some work tools in the back seat. The owner was current on his payments and had all the vehicle keys in his possession. The vehicle was entered into LEIN as stolen.

#### **DOMESTIC ASSAULT**

On January 10<sup>th</sup> officers responded to a residence on a domestic dispute. The investigation found the husband had pushed his wife twice. The husband was arrested and charged with domestic assault.

#### **FIRE ALARM**

On January 10<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 10:15 p.m., officers responded to Farmington Health Care for a report of a fire alarm. Upon arrival officers learned that the alarm was caused by a low

pressure in the fire system. The alarm company was contacted who advised that they would send out a technician to address the alarm.

**DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED**

On January 11<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 6:20 p.m., an officer on patrol stopped a Pontiac Grand Prix in the area of Grand River and Mooney for an improper lane use. A subsequent investigation revealed that the driver of the vehicle has a suspended license and two warrants for his arrest for traffic violations out of Detroit. The driver was arrested for Driving While License Suspended and was housed at the Farmington jail.
