## WEEKLY REPORT

### December 9 - 15, 2013

#### **WARRANT ARREST OTHER DEPARTMENT**

On December 9<sup>th</sup> officers were dispatched to a residence on Colchester Street on a report of two suspicious males near the backyard of a residence. Upon arrival contact was made with both subjects whom were working for a property conservation company to do work at the residence. A check on both subjects revealed that one of them had an outstanding warrant out of Dearborn for Breach of Peace. Subject was arrested and transported to the station to be picked up by Dearborn police.

#### **NEVER ACQUIRED DRIVER'S LICENSE**

On December 10<sup>th</sup> an officer stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation at Grand River and Gill Road. Upon making contact with the driver, the driver was found to have an expired Temporary Instruction Permit (TIP). The driver was arrested for Never Acquired Driver's License and transported to the station.

#### **DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED**

On December 10<sup>th</sup> an officer stopped a vehicle for a speeding violation at Grand River and Shiawassee Road. Upon making contact with the driver it was found that the driver had a suspended driver's license. The driver was arrested for Driving While License Suspended and transported to the station.

#### **DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED**

On December 10<sup>th</sup> an officer stopped a vehicle for equipment violations on Gill Road near Arundel Street. Upon making contact with the driver, it was found that the driver had a suspended driver's license along with several outstanding warrants out of other departments. The driver was arrested for Driving While License Suspended and the warrants from another department. The driver was transported to the station to be held pending posting of bond.

#### **LARCENY**

On December 11<sup>th</sup> an officer took a front desk report on a larceny that occurred at T.J. Maxx. An unknown suspect stole a wallet from a shopping cart. A request has been made for any in store video.

**DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED**

On December 11<sup>th</sup> an officer stopped a vehicle for speeding on Drake Road near Oakland Street. Upon making contact with the driver, it was found that the driver had a suspended driver's license along with an outstanding warrant out of another department. The driver was arrested for Driving While License Suspended and the warrant from another agency. The driver was then transported to the station to be held pending posting of bond.

**OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED SECOND OFFENSE**

On December 12<sup>th</sup> an officer stopped a vehicle on Farmington near Nine Mile for driving without headlights activated. The officer detected an odor of intoxicants coming from the interior of the vehicle. The driver denied consuming alcohol. The driver failed field sobriety tests with a PBT of .10(6). The driver was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) and the vehicle was impounded. The driver submitted to a breath test at the station with a result of .09. The driver had a previous OWI on his driving record. The driver was housed until sober. The report was forwarded to the Oakland County Prosecutor's Office for review.

**OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED THIRD OFFENSE**

On December 13<sup>th</sup> an officer stopped a vehicle on Grand River near Halsted for improper lane use. The officer detected an odor of intoxicants and Marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. The driver denied consuming alcohol or smoking Marijuana. The driver failed field sobriety tests and refused a PBT. The driver was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated (OWI). An inventory search of the vehicle produced a small baggie of Marijuana in a Styrofoam cup in the center console. The officer confiscated the baggie. The driver refused a breath test at the station and a search warrant for blood was prepared and authorized. A blood draw was completed by CEMS. The driver was housed until sober. The driver had two previous convictions for OWI on his driving record. The report was forwarded to Oakland County Prosecutor's Office for review.

**NOTE:** Dayshift responded to 8 motor vehicle accidents during the week.

## **WINTER TIPS TO KEEP YOU SAFE**

- Change the batteries in your smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors once a year.
  - Replace monitors ten years old or older.
- Keep your chimney and fireplace clean.
- Have your furnace/heating system inspected and clean.
  - don't store newspapers, rags or other combustible materials near the furnace, hot water heater, space heater, etc.
  - don't leave space heaters unattended.
  - keep space heaters three feet away from anything that might burn, including the wall
  - don't use extension cords on space heaters
  - never use your gas range for heat
- Prepare your vehicle.
  - check the tire tread and pressure, and fluid levels
  - keep your gas tank full or near full
  - carry a flashlight, flares, ice scraper, tools, spare tire
- Safe shoveling tips.
  - talk to your doctor if you have heart problems
  - warm up and stretch prior to shoveling
  - keep yourself hydrated
  - shovel only freshly fallen snow before it becomes packed down
  - push, don't lift the snow
  - use your legs instead of your back
  - dress in layers
  - listen to your body... quit shoveling if you are experiencing any pain, dizziness, fainting, sweating or nausea, and/or shortness of breath. Get medical help immediately.
