WEEKLY RECAP

October 30, 2017 through November 05, 2017

DWLS, Warrant and OWI Arrests

Between October 30th and November 5th, FDPS personnel made eight misdemeanor driver license related and warrant arrests, and two operating while intoxicated arrests as a result of conducting proactive traffic enforcement.

Open Intoxicants Motor Vehicle

On 10/31/17 at approximately 3:35 am officers responded to a business near 10 Mile and Orchard Lake regarding an intoxicated female in a vehicle in the parking lot. Upon arrival, officers located the vehicle running but legally parked. An intoxicated 28 year old female was sitting in the driver’s seat. Officers located an open bottle of Long Island Ice Tea in the center console of the vehicle. The female was cited for Open Intoxicants MV and transported to her residence. The vehicle remained in the parking lot with management permission.

Suspicious Circumstances

On 11/03/17 a resident on Violet street filed a front desk report regarding receiving a bill from Consumers Energy for a residence in Rhodes, Michigan. The R/P has never lived in Rhodes, Michigan. Follow up by detectives revealed the homeowner in Rhodes has the same name as the R/P. Consumers was informed of their mistake in their account records.

Marijuana Possession

On 11/04/17 at approximately 1:50 AM a Sergeant stopped an unregistered motor vehicle at Grand River and Halsted. Upon making contact with the 26 year old male driver, the Sergeant detected a strong odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. A vehicle search revealed 1.8 grams of marijuana in the center console of the vehicle. The marijuana was confiscated and the driver arrested. The vehicle was impounded. The driver was cited for Marijuana Possession and housed at the police department.
