SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

Fraud

On January 11th a Cass Ct resident reported at the police front desk that he was the victim of a fraud. The victim advised that he had notice a charge to his PayPal account from a service that he had already cancelled. The victim called PayPal and was transferred to a call taker who was supposed to assist him with his issue. The call taker from PayPal convinced the victim that his computer had been “hacked” and that he needed to provide the call taker with gift cards so that they can track where the money was going. The victim provided the suspect with \$1,600 worth of gift cards before he realized that he was being scammed. The incident was turned over to the detective bureau for further investigation and PayPal was notified that they potentially have an employee who is defrauding customers.
