SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

Fire Alarm

On January 31st officers and Engine 1 responded to the AT&T building on Grand River Ave for a report of a fire alarm activation. Upon arrival officers checked the alarm panel and noted that the alarm activated due to smoke in the boiler room. Officers checked the boiler and noted that it had malfunctioned. Management from AT&T was notified of the incident and the scene was turned over to an AT&T representative.

Fraud

On January 31st a Folkstone Rd. resident reported that she had noticed that \$2,000 had been transferred to a credit card from her checking account without her approval. Upon further investigation the victim learned from her bank that the credit card that was paid by her checking account was owned by a roofer that she had hired and paid using a check. The victim confronted the roofer, who denied paying his credit card using the victim's banking info. The incident was turned over to the detective bureau for further investigation.

Flee and Elude

On February 5th at approximately 3:44 AM an officer on patrol attempted to stop a dark colored Dodge Challenger for speeding in the area of Grand River Ave and Farmington Rd. As the officer activated the squad car's overhead lights and siren, the Challenger fled at dangerously high speeds. Due to traffic safety concerns, the pursuit was terminated.
