### SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

#### Fraud

On June 15<sup>th</sup> a Brookdale Condo resident reported at the police front desk that she was the victim of a scam. The victim advised the officer that on the day before she was contacted by an unknown person who advised that he knew that the victim was being scammed and that he was going to help her protect her money. The suspect convinced the victim to purchase \$4,000 worth of gift cards and then to provide him with the card numbers. The victim did as she was instructed. On June 15<sup>th</sup> the suspect called the victim again and told her to purchase \$15,000 worth of gift cards so that he could refund her the original \$4,000. At that point the victim realized that she had been scammed. The report was forwarded to the detective bureau for further investigation.

#### Flee and Elude

On June 16<sup>th</sup> an officer on patrol observed a vehicle speeding on Drake Rd. The officer activated her lights and siren and the suspect vehicle suddenly accelerated away from the officer. The officer pursued the suspect vehicle as it suddenly turned into the Heritage Condo Complex and drove down a dead end street. With nowhere to escape, the driver of the vehicle surrendered. The suspect admitted to fleeing due to not having a driver's license and having warrants for her arrest.
