SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

Operate While Intoxicated

On May 7th an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle at Grand River Ave and Lakeway and arrested the driver for operating while intoxicated. While the officer was investigating the OWI, the driver's boyfriend walked up to the traffic stop as he lived close by. The boyfriend asked the officer about the driver's arrest and while the officer was talking with the boyfriend, the officer noted that the boyfriend was heavily intoxicated. The boyfriend asked about picking up the driver from the Farmington Jail and the officer instructed the boyfriend to not drive as he was obviously intoxicated. The officer even offered to drive the driver home after she was sober.

The officer transported the driver to the Farmington Public Safety Department where he observed the boyfriend drive into the parking lot and park in two parking spaces. The officer turned the intoxicated driver over to another officer for booking while he arrested the boyfriend for operating while intoxicated. Both the boyfriend and the driver were housed at the Farmington Jail till sober.
