### SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

#### IDENTITY THEFT:

Officers discovered evidence that developed two juvenile suspects. The juveniles involved were issued a no trespass order for the property involved.

The resident reported that they were contacted by someone via phone advising they were with the Inspector General’s office. The caller convinced the resident that by providing them with gift cards they would no longer be a suspect in their investigation.
