<u>Description:</u> City Manager Recommendation to Amend City Charter to Increase City Council Compensation

Requested Action:

Discussion and possible direction to staff/attorney to prepare proposed charter amendment ballot language

Background:

City Council's annual compensation of \$1,800 per year is established by City Charter. The compensation amount was last revised in November 1999. I am recommending that the City Council place on the November 2015 Ballot a charter amendment to increase the compensation to \$3,000 per year. A cursory review of city council compensation based on the Michigan Municipal League's 2014 salary wage study shows that Farmington City Council member receive less than their counterparts of similar sized cities. I will also tell you the level of community engagement of Farmington City Council members is dramatically more than what you find in other cities.

As part of the process of determining whether to go forward with this recommendation, I would suggest that the City Council consider an ad hoc committee to review the increase amount and instruct the City Attorney to prepare draft ballot language in which the only item to be added is the compensation amount. The City Council will need to act upon this at their July or August regular meeting in order to have it on the November ballot.

As an aside, when I left the City of Clare as their manager in May 1997, on the very last agenda I incorporated a recommendation to increase their compensation as well.
