**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that any qualified elector of the City of Farmington who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the City Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at [mi.gov/vote](http://mi.gov/vote) and mailed to the City Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at [www.expressSOS.com](http://www.expressSOS.com).

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **Monday, February 24, 2020**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the City of Farmington Clerk's office, located at 23600 Liberty Street, Farmington, MI 48335 at the following times:

- Regular business hours: Monday – Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Saturday, March 7 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Election Day, Tuesday, March 10 from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
