STATEWIDE PROPOSALS

PROPOSAL 18-1: A PROPOSAL INITIATED LAW TO AUTHORIZE AND LEGALIZE POSSESSION, USE AND CULTIVATION OF MARIJUANA PRODUCTS BY INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER, AND COMMERCIAL SALES OF MARIJUANA THROUGH STATE-LICENSED RETAILERS

PROPOSAL 18-2: A PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO ESTABLISH A COMMISSION OF CITIZENS WITH EXCLUSIVE AUTHORITY TO ADOPT DISTRICT BOUNDARIES FOR THE MICHIGAN SENATE, MICHIGAN HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND U.S. CONGRESS, EVERY 10 YEARS

PROPOSAL 18-3: A PROPOSAL TO AUTHORIZE AUTOMATIC AND ELECTION DAY VOTER REGISTRATION, NO-REASON ABSENTEE VOTING, AND STRAIGHT TICKET VOTING; AND ADD CURRENT LEGAL REQUIREMENTS FOR MILITARY AND OVERSEAS VOTING AND POST-ELECTION AUDITS TO THE MICHIGAN CONSTITUTION

CITY PROPOSAL

CHARTER AMENDMENT PROPOSAL 1: AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 9.1 OF THE CITY CHARTER TO ADD SECTION 9.1(A) TO AUTHORIZE THE LEVY OF UP TO 3.0 MILLS (\$3.00 FOR EVERY \$1,000) OF TAXABLE VALUE) FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES, AT LEAST HALF OF WHICH (1.5 MILLS) MUST BE USED TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND CAPITAL PROJECTS, FOR A PERIOD OF 10 YEARS, FROM 2019 TO 2028.
