City of Farmington **Mayfield Street Gas Main Construction**

You should have been previously notified by Consumers Energy of gas main construction occurring along Mayfield Street from Slocum to Cloverdale. This work, to be done by Consumers, will begin the week of April 20, 2020 and will take place within the right-of-way on both sides of the street. There are no anticipated impacts to each residence's gas service or driveway access at this time. However, once the new gas main is constructed the old main and services will need to be retired. This retirement will not happen until either Consumers can access homes to perform "relighting" of the gas services or residents can perform this relighting themselves. Due to the COVID-19 situation, Consumers is not currently permitted to enter homes in order to perform the relight. Please be advised that this relighting process can be done by each resident and this may be asked of you to do.

This gas main work is necessary to be completed prior to the start of the Mayfield Street Reconstruction project which is under a separate contract and planned to begin immediately following the completion of the Consumers Energy gas main construction. A **Public Meeting** is planned for the Mayfield Street Reconstruction project on **Thursday, May 7th at 6:00 pm**. At this time, the location of this meeting is undecided due to the Governor's stay-at-home orders. Should those orders be loosened, the meeting could be hosted at City Hall. Otherwise, the meeting will be held virtually by use of Zoom meetings. Should this meeting be held via Zoom all residents will receive necessary information for accessing the meeting.

Please keep children and pets away from the construction operation. Construction activities, and the associated equipment that goes with it, is attractive to small children and can be dangerous. Please keep children away from the equipment, removals, mass grading, underground utility installation, and wet concrete.
