



NOVEMBER 5, 2019 CITY GENERAL ELECTION

CITY COUNCIL FILING DEADLINES

PETITIONS ARE NOW AVAILABLE at the Office of the City Clerk, 23600 Liberty Street, Farmington, for the nomination of candidates for THREE seats on the Farmington City Council.

PETITIONS may be requested from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, and must be filed by **Tuesday, JULY 23, 2019 by 4:00 P.M.** All candidates who qualify will be placed on the ballot. There is no Primary Election. Voters will elect THREE Councilpersons on a Non-Partisan ballot at a Regular Election on Tuesday, November 5, 2019.

Candidates for nomination must have the following qualifications:

- Must be a qualified, registered elector of the City of Farmington on July 23, 2019 and throughout tenure of office and have been a resident of the City for one year.
- May not be in default to the City or any other governmental unit of the State.
- Must submit petitions signed by at least 50 and not more than 75 qualified registered electors by 4:00 p.m. on July 23, 2019.
- Must submit an affidavit of identity in duplicate by 4:00 p.m. on July 23, 2019.
- Must submit an affidavit as to name change (if applicable).

The terms of Councilmembers Sara Bowman, Joe LaRussa, and Steve Schneemann will expire in 2019.
