Possess and maintain Residential Builders' License
issued by the State of Michigan

- Be a certified Michigan Department of Community Health Lead Abatement Contractor
- Carry Commercial General Liability, Automobile Liability, and Workers' Compensation insurance coverage in amounts required by Oakland County
- Adhere to Michigan Residential Code
- Be reliable and complete projects on time
