#### SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

#### **Felonious Assault**

02/13/2024 at approximately 11:00 a.m. officers were dispatched to the area of Grand River and Halsted for a fight in progress. Officers arrived and found a male and a female in a verbal argument that stemmed from a road rage argument on M5. Officers conducted an investigation on scene and through statements obtained by witnesses determined that the 29-year-old female had obtained a box cutter and swung it at the male in an attempt to injure him. The female was placed under arrest for felonious assault and lodged for arraignment. The victim did not suffer any injuries and was able to leave from the scene. The case was forwarded on to the Oakland County Prosecutors Officer for a warrant request.

## Fraud by Wire

On February 17, 2024 at approximately 2:00 p.m. officers took a front desk report of Fraud. The victim reported to have received a notification from Microsoft indicating that immediate action needed to be taken. The victim called the number provided from the notification. The victim noticed that the person from Microsoft took control of his computer and demanded money. The victim provided his credit card and debit card information over the phone. The victim became suspicious and terminated the phone call. The suspect is unknown currently. The victim reported the incident to his financial institutions. The case has been forwarded on to the detective bureau for investigation.
